## **Statement on Traffic Calming Measures 13-07-2018**

A temporary closure is scheduled for this Saturday, 14<sup>th</sup> July, from 7:30 am until mid-afternoon. The works are on Upper Main Street where tarmacing will be taking place.

There will be works throughout the village on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> July as follows:

- White Lining will be happening from the gateway on Upper Main Street up past Little India which may result in temporary road closures between 9:30 and 15:30.
- The roundabout area will be closed from 09:30-15:30 on both days to allow planing and surfacing with anti-skid tarmac along the approaches on Efflinch Lane, Station Road and Main Street together with associated lining.

Works to complete the other planned traffic calming measures in Bar Lane, Dogs Head Lane, Dunstall Road, Efflinch Lane and Station Road will be completed in September once work on the Square is complete.

EON will be installing new lighting columns along Station Road and Main Street from the 19<sup>th</sup> July, with the main project starting on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. The existing lights will be replaced with new steel columns with LED lighting and then painted black.

A reminder that Main Street from just below Church Lane to just past Dunstall Road will be closed from 30<sup>th</sup> July to 31<sup>st</sup> August. While the road is closed there will be access for local traffic only. Please report any HGVs seen travelling through the village (via Efflinch Lane, Wales Lane, Short Lane, Captains Lane etc.) to the Parish Council (company, number plate and time together with a photo if appropriate) so we can follow it up with Staffordshire Highways.

We thank you for your continued patience whilst these works are completed.

It is with regret that we have learnt today that a build out on Bar Lane cannot be done due to the lack of street lighting. The speed limit will still be extended and a gateway will be installed.
