Statement on Traffic Calming Measures and The Square 03-08-2018

To allow for access to the Shoulder of Mutton by customers and deliveries entrance to the work area is being controlled during the day using operatives. For the evening/weekend customers access is available from each end of the works. We stress '**for access**', the road is not open. We recommend extreme caution if using that area as a through route which you do at your own risk.

The Square - Kerbing and block paving works are on programme for completion ahead of the end of the Summer holidays and the road closure will be removed before the schools re-open in September. You will note we are also using some reclaimed materials. Signed diversion routes are in place cover all major roads into and out of Barton with supplementary information signs on many side roads advising motorists of the closure.

Note a 'Silent Soldier' will appear at the War Memorial on 8/8 and be there for 100 days. The bollards around the war memorial will be replaced and the ironwork is being refurbished.

Eon Road Lighting Upgrade - works commenced on 17 July 2018 and will continue throughout August. Some columns will be installed pre-painted and others will be painted in-situ.

Other traffic calming works – current position:

- Barton Gate, Little India, Forest Road – kerbs, tarmac white lining completed – signs to install.
- Upper Main Street Squeeze – tarmac still to be completed. Road markings completed. Non-safety bollards to be replaced with wood or wood effect bollards.
- Mini roundabout, tarmac and road markings completed but bitumen staining to centre of island needs rectifying. Eon signing to be installed as they progress with the road lighting upgrade. Yellow lines need to be redone in canary yellow as it is in the conservation area.
- Squeeze by the telephone exchange - will be started after the works in the Square are completed.
- Barton Turns (Marina) – tarmac and white lining to complete. Will be phased in with similar activities as above. Gates to be improved and repositioned following a meeting between the Parish Council, SCC, ESBC and Amey. Trees to be planned. Planting to be agreed. Will be applied to all gateways.
- New Efflinch Lane Squeeze – Works to be done once the Square is completed.
- Works associated with Gateways and alterations of 30 mph speed limits on Dogs Head Lane, Bar Lane, Efflinch Lane and Station Road and the gateway on Dunstall Road will be progressed after the works in the Square are completed.

None of these works would be possible without the support of Barton and Dunstall Key Trust, Aggregate Industries, Simon Clarke, the ESBC Neighbourhood Fund, SCC and Staffordshire Safer Roads. Together with Amey and their sub contractors, Bartrams Joinery and Dragon Forge who are doing the works.
