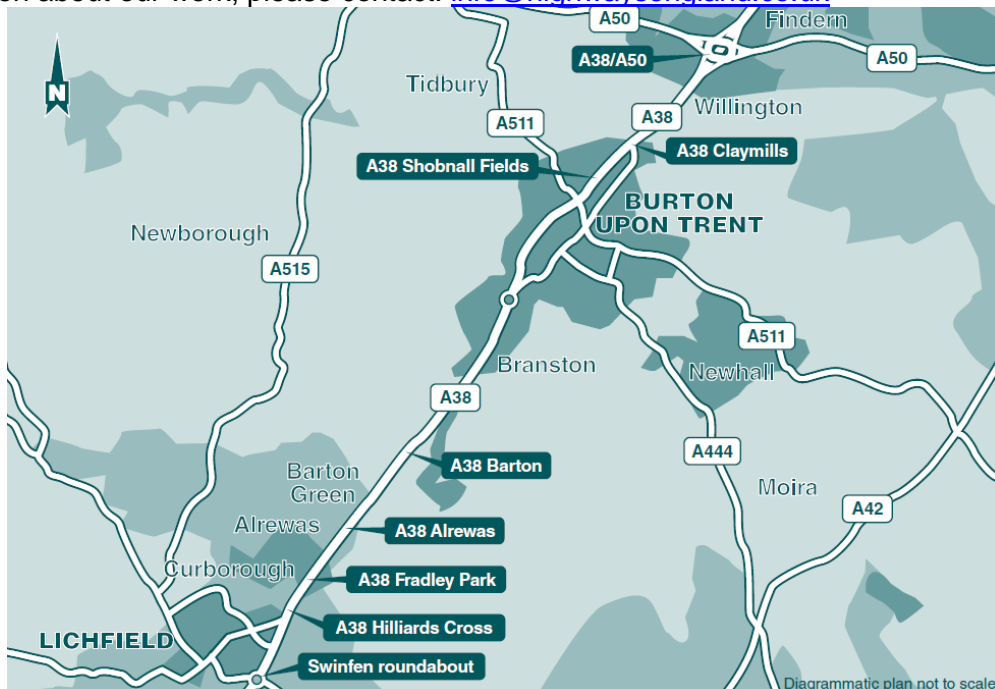
We have been working on upgrading the drainage between Branston junction and Claymills junction and we will continue in this area until the end of July.

One thing to note this week is the Saturday 20 June night time closure of the A38 southbound between Branston junction and Barton Turns. This is to carry out some repairs following a recent traffic accident. This includes the southbound Barton Turn entry slip.

Restrictions in place 24/7 for the duration of the work:

- Narrow lanes in place on the southbound A38 through Barton Turn and the 50mph speed limits are being enforced via speed camera.
- On the local road above the A38 at Barton Turn (B5016/Station Road) 3-way traffic lights in operation to allow us to work on our repairs to the bridge.
